



# EMC Europe 2019 BARCELONA

## Instructions to submit a Paper

Prospective authors are invited to submit original papers for review not later than February 15th, 2019 (23:59 CET), using the [conference system \(ConfTool\)](#).

Only full-text papers of 4 to 6 pages (including figures, tables, photos, and references) are expected as a contribution.

Papers have to be written in English and comply with the conference technical areas:

- EMI Sources
- Transmission Lines
- Shielding and Grounding
- Measurements
- Materials & Sensors
- EMC in Transport Systems
- EMC Theory, Analysis, and Simulation
- EMC in Power Electronics
- EMC in Communications
- EMC of Components and Integrated Circuits

- System-Level EMC
- Human Exposure and Health Protection
- EMC in Medical Devices
- EMC Standards, Management & Regulations
- EMC & Safety & Security
- EMC in Industrial Environments
- EMC in Military Applications
- EMC in the Internet of Things
- EMC Validation of Large Systems
- Power Integrity, Signal Integrity
- Any other relevant topics related to EMC

After the peer review process, the accepted final papers will be requested by **May 15th, 2019** combined with **at least one full registration for each accepted paper**.



## STAGE 1: PREPARE AND SUBMIT YOUR PAPER

Prepare your manuscript following the two-column A4 format of the IEEE Manuscript Template for Conference Proceedings. Papers must be electronic in PDF (Portable Document Format). Any formats other than PDF, as well as hardcopies, abstracts and summaries will neither be accepted nor considered for review.

The IEEE Manuscript Templates for Conference Proceedings in Microsoft Word and  $\text{\LaTeX}$  format are available at [IEEE Manuscript Templates for Conference Proceedings](#). Be sure to use the latest version of the Microsoft Word or  $\text{\LaTeX}$  template. Please note that templates and instructions are the same before and after the peer-review process (Stages 1 and 2).

Once your manuscript is ready to be submitted, please log in into the EMC Europe 2019 conference system (ConfTool), create a new submission following the instructions for filling in all the requested information and upload the PDF version of your paper before **February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 (23:59 CET)**. Please make sure to enter the contact information for all co-authors as they will be notified by e-mail whenever a submission is created, modified or when a decision has been reached.

Upon completion of the peer-review process, prospective authors will be notified by e-mail regarding the acceptance or rejection of their contributions, along with a report containing the reviewer's comments that justify the decision. **In case of acceptance, continue to the next stage.**

## STAGE 2: UPLOAD THE FINAL PAPER

Authors of accepted and/or conditionally accepted papers must prepare and upload the final version of their contribution before **May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.

Remember, in order to process a paper, it is mandatory that at least one author for each accepted paper is fully registered in advance (as a **Regular** or as a **Student** participant).

Regarding the preparation of the final paper, authors are requested to improve their final papers using the corresponding comments and suggestions from the reviewers.

Then, it is strongly recommended that all final manuscripts are generated using the PDF Xpress tool. To generate the IEEE Xplore® compatible PDF file of the final paper, please follow these steps:

1. Create your IEEE PDF eXpress account: <http://www.pdf-express.org>
2. Use the conference ID code. This code will be provided later to the authors of the accepted papers.
3. The first time you access the system, please follow the link to new user. Please note that in order to access the service, you need to allow the use of cookies from the PDF eXpress web site. Once you have registered as a new user:
  - Upload the source file (containing your paper) for conversion.
  - Receive by e-mail the IEEE Xplore®-compatible PDF of your paper.

When your final paper is ready and compliant to be uploaded, log in into the EMC Europe 2019 conference system (ConfTool), select "Your Submissions", click on "Full Paper" and fill in all requested information.

Final papers might be subject of minor edits to make them completely IEEEExplore compatible, for adding pagination and the IEEE copyright clearance code. The authors will be requested by email to approve this camera-ready version of their final papers.

The papers will be automatically checked for plagiarism using the IEEE CrossCheck portal. All the papers with a moderate or high risk of suffering from plagiarism will be examined individually to reach a decision regarding the possibility of unethical behaviour. Those articles in which plagiarism is detected will be automatically rejected.

Final papers compliant with the previously described requirements will be submitted for publication in the IEEE Xplore® database, one of the most comprehensive interdisciplinary engineering databases in the world.

Therefore, for every paper, the electronic IEEE Copyright Form needs to be signed when the final paper is submitted.

Please note that IEEE reserves the right to exclude a submission from distribution after the conference, including exclusion from IEEE Xplore®, if the submission does not meet IEEE standards or if it is not presented at the conference. Articles excluded from further distribution shall be archived by IEEE but shall not be indexed or appear on IEEE Xplore®.
